4. Complete some research into favourite Asian meals. Create a tally chart and ask friends and family what their favourite meal is. Use this data to create a bar chart.

7. Create a flag for Asia by combining the designs from different Asian countries.
8. Complete research into martial arts and complete a fact file about one of them or a non-chronological report about a few.

10. Watch an anime film with your family and write a review of it.
